DIU Ranked #1 in Bangladesh in the QS Sustainability Rankings 2026

Daffodil International University was ranked #1 in Bangladesh in the QS Sustainability Rankings 2026, released on 18 November 2025. DIU secured #112 in Asia and #484 globally among 2,002 universities, earning an overall score of 69.5/100. This achievement reflected the university's strong commitment to sustainability.

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DIU Achieves 221st Position in QS Asia University Rankings 2026

Daffodil International University (DIU) secured 221st position in Asia in the QS World University Rankings: Asia 2026, improving from last year's 280th position. DIU is now ranked 43rd in South Asia, 2nd among private universities, and 4th among all universities in Bangladesh. Recognized as a "Very High Research-Intensive University".

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DIU Ranked Among Top 400 Globally in THE Interdisciplinary Science Rankings 2026

Daffodil International University was ranked within the Top 400 globally (351–400 band) in the Times Higher Education Interdisciplinary Science Rankings 2026 and 1st among private universities in Bangladesh. This recognition reflects DIU's commitment to interdisciplinary research and its ongoing efforts to address global challenges through academic excellence.

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


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Pen and Perspective

Conquering exam Phobia

It is normal to have some nervous stress or anxiety about exams, but when this turns into fear or a phobia, it hinders your normal functioning. In many cases, it causes physical and mental problems, panic attacks or breathing problems. Remember that an exam does not measure a person's complete knowledge or ability, it measures a moment in time. Here are some strategies on how to change from fear to confidence.

*** Acknowledge the Fear:** Fear is a feeling, Accept whatever feeling is being tested as normal. Don't try to push the fear away. Notice the physical reactions that occur during fear. Without judgement simply observing it.

*** Dealing with negative thoughts:** Negative thoughts disturb our mind which interferes with daily activities. Talk positively to yourself every day. Replace "I will forget everything when I have an exam" saying positively to yourself "Because I have studied well I will remember everything during the exam, I feel like because of my nervousness"

***Set Plan and time management:** Having a realistic, structured routine. Breaking the Big syllabus into smaller parts, a proper planning and proper estimation of time reduces our stress and makes work easier.

***Avoid Comparison:** The assumption is that people have their own capabilities. Trying to discover and use their own skills and hidden abilities. Comparing yourself to others only create inferiority.

*** Practice Mindfulness and Relaxation:** By trying to stay in the present, regular breathing exercises help reduce tension, mental stress and restlessness.

*** Prioritize well-being and seek help:** Ensure adequate nutrition, food and sleep, Physical exercise and water intake. If you can't overcome fear and stress even after all this, you can definitely take the help of a psychologist or mental health expert.

By implementing the above, you can transform your fears into confidence that will give you more success in exam.

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
